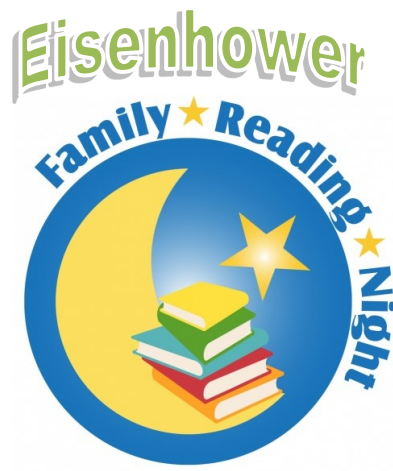

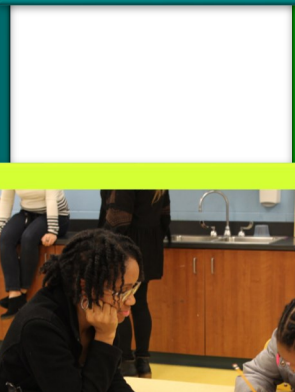
HAPPY Thanksgiving

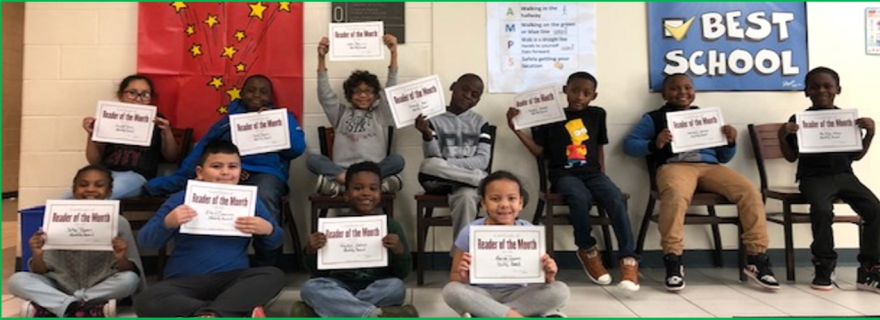
Madison's Student Council collected over 850 canned goods and non-perishable items during their annual Holiday Food Drive.
